

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

CSGA OPEN QUALIFIER
JUNE 25, 2007
THE COUNTRY CLUB OF FARMINGTON

THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION CARD AND THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS.

FORMAT – 18-hole qualifier at stroke play. Players with the 28 lowest scores, plus ties, will qualify for the Championship July 30 at the Lake of Isles..

FOOTWEAR: It is a condition of this competition that shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition:

DISQUALIFICATION.

CELLULAR PHONE: Use of a cellular phone or similar device by a contestant or caddie during the stipulated round is strictly **PROHIBITED**

TEES – Play will be from the Blue Tees.

YARDAGE MARKINGS–

- Sprinkler Heads and 100, 150, 200-yard stones in the fairway all to the center of the greens.

HOLE LOCATIONS – Pin sheets will be available at the reception table.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by walls, fences and white stakes. A ball on or over Waterville Rd. is OB. Also, the maintenance area on Hole 17 is OB.

FLOWER BED: triangle flowerbed in the middle of cart paths that service the 7th and 13th holes is considered part of the obstruction.

DROP AREAS: behind the 9th green there are two drop areas for optional relief from the cart path and service road. The player must use the closer drop area.

PACE OF PLAY: Players will be apprised of their pace of play periodically by on course officials. Additionally, each score card indicates your expected finish time for each hole. See attached for the “CSGA Pace of Play Guidelines”.

Notes:

- All stone walls on the course are considered to be integral parts of the course
- Return scorecards promptly to Scoreboard area located outside the club house on the terrace overlooking the 18th green
