NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS.

FORMAT: 36 holes at stroke play. All contestants will play 18 holes on Tuesday. All players who are within 80% & ties of the low score will advance to play more 18 holes on Wednesday. The player with the lowest 36 hole score is The Champion. In case of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following the last stipulated round on Wednesday. The play-off will begin at the 17th hole, then the 18th & repeat as long as needed. All other places will be shared. There is also a prize for low amateur.

TEES: Play will be from the Blue CSGA tee markers.

HOLE LOCATIONS: Hole location charts are available at the reception table. All paces are from the extreme front of the green & to the closest side of the green.

YARDAGE MARKINGS: All sprinkler heads have yardages to the center of the green.

STONE WALLS: All stonewalls & rocks, on the course, are considered an integral part of the golf course.

FLOWERBEDS: All flowerbeds are GUR & free relief MUST be taken.

HOLE # 18: A ball over the green & onto the cart path or parking lot is on an obstruction. Drop ball at nearest drop area.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Holes # 7, 8, 10 & 12

On left

Hole # 9

On left & behind green

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS & WATER HAZARDS:

Holes # 3, 4, 5 & 6

POWER LINES & TOWERS:

Holes # 3 & 8

Must cancel shot & replay. No penalty

CONDITIONS: Per the Letter to Contestants, the players are reminded that the following are in effect:

Cellular phones, Footwear, Dress code.

PLEASE remember use of cell phones are allowed in your car & locker room only.

Any questions, please ask at the reception table or the starters table.

PACE OF PLAY: Please read the “CSGA Pace of Play Guidelines”. If you are out of position & behind time, your group is subject to be timed. All necessary information was attached to letter to contestants. It is your responsibility to keep up with the group in front of you.

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: If a Rules Official is not immediately available, a player may play a second ball under Rule 3-3 & then you must report it to the committee before signing their score card.
