NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION CARD AND THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS.

FORMAT: All contestants will play 18 holes on Monday, June 18th & 18 holes on Tuesday, June 19th. The 32 players with the lowest 36-hole scores will advance to match play, beginning at 8A.M. on Wednesday, June 20th. In case of a tie for the last qualifying position, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off starting immediately following the last stipulated round on Tuesday. The play-off will start on the 1st hole, followed by the 16th, 17th & 18th holes, if needed. This series will be repeated, if necessary.

TEES: All play will be from The CSGA Blue Tees.

HOLE LOCATIONS: There will be new hole locations each day. Location sheets are available at the reception table.

PRACTICE RANGE: Open one hour before first tee time. Balls are courtesy of the CSGA.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by white stakes or fences

STONE WALLS: All on course stone walls are an integral part of the golf course. No free relief.

PACE OF PLAY: There is a large field. Please pay attention to the CSGA's new Pace of Play Guidelines. If you watch the time on your scorecard & stay up with the group on front of you, all players will have a pleasant day.

CONDITIONS:

Players are reminded that the following conditions are in effect:

Footwear, cellular phones, dress code.
