

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

26th Senior Four-Ball Championship
July 2, 2007
Hartford Golf Club

FORMAT: 18 holes of better ball stroke play. The team with the lowest score will be the Champions. Only the player whose score counts for that hole needs to have his score recorded on the card. If your score will not count, we encourage you to pick up in order to save time. In the event of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off starting immediately after the last stipulated round. The play-off will begin at the 1st hole, then 17th & 18th holes, if needed, & will be replayed until the Champions are decided.

PRIZES: There is a trophy for the winners & runner-ups. Also, there is merchandise credit for the first 7 teams.

TEES: Play will be from the CSGA Blue tee markers.

INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE GOLF COURSE: The service road, which is in the woods on the right side of hole # 7 & runs parallel to the 7th hole, is an integral part of the course. Also, all, on course, stonewalls are integral parts of the course. No free relief from either condition.

OUT OF BOUNDS: OB is defined by the inside edges, at ground level, of white stakes &/or property fence posts. On holes # 4 & 7, where applicable, the boundary is defined by the split rail fence posts.

Hole # 2	Behind green
Hole # 4	Left & behind green
Hole # 8 & 10	Right
Hole # 9 & 17	Right & behind green
Hole 12 & 14	Behind green
Hole # 15	Left (boundary fence only)
Hole # 18	Left near tennis court area

WATER HAZARDS & LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:

Hole # 5, 7 & 11	Lateral on left
Hole # 13	Water hazard crosses fairway
Hole # 14	Lateral right & left
Hole # 15	Lateral on right

IMMOVALBE OBSTRUCTIONS: Some lateral water hazards (holes # 5 & 14) have stakes with string attached to them for Goose Control. The stakes & Strings are in the hazards & are **immovable obstructions**. No relief. If your ball lies outside the hazard, you are entitled to free relief (Rule 24), if interfered with by the stakes or the string.

CONDITIONS: Players are reminded that the following conditions are in effect:
Cellular phones, Footwear & Dress Code

PACE OF PLAY: See CSGA pace of Play Guidelines attached. Please keep up with the group in front of you & everyone will enjoy the day.
