

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Connecticut Two-Man Team Invitational
May 8th, 2007
The Club at River Oaks

THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS.

FORMAT: The competition consists of an 18-hole team better ball score in the AM & foursome (selected drive) for the PM. The team with the lowest 36-hole score will be the Champions. There is a prize for the over-all Champion, Runner-up & for the lowest round in the AM & PM. Teams may not win more than one trophy. In addition, the low four teams will win River Oaks Golf Shop merchandise credit. We will use the low score in the PM round as the first tiebreaker for Golf Shop merchandize. After that we'll use The USGA recommended procedure of match of cards for merchandise gifts. If there is a tie for the Championship, a hole-by-hole play off will start on the 18th hole, followed by the 17th & 18th. This will be repeated if necessary. The format will be foursome play. No select drive.

TEES: Play will be from the CSGA Blue Tee Markers.

HOLE LOCATIONS: Obtain hole location sheet at the reception table. All paces are from the extreme front of the greens & 90 degrees to the side of the green.

HOLE # 2: The area that crosses the fairway is a Water Hazard, NOT an Environmentally Sensitive Area.

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS: These areas are marked with yellow or red stakes with **green tops**. You are not allowed in these areas, even to retrieve a ball. If you play out of these areas or stand in these areas to make a stroke, the penalty is two strokes. If the player's ball lies through the green & the ESA interferes with his stance or area of intended swing, the player MUST take free relief. Establish the nearest point of relief, then one club length, not nearer the hole. Just about every hole as an ESA on the left or right.

STONE WALLS: All, on course, stone walls are considered an integral part of the golf course. No free relief.

SCORES CARDS: In the AM round, only the score for the player whose score is to count for that hole should be written on the card. Besides the marker, only one signature per team is required. **PLEASE RETURN THE SCORE CARD TO THE SCORE BOARD.**

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Holes # 1, 2, 5, 7, 8

On the Left

Holes # 7, 11, 12,13

On the Right

Hole # 16

On the left, near the house, but not
OB if over the road.

POWER LINES & TOWERS: Must cancel & replay stroke. No penalty.

CONDITIONS: Per the Letter to Contestants, the players are reminded that the following conditions are in effect:

Dress Code, Footwear, Cellular Phones
