THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION CARD.

FORMAT: All contestants will play 18 holes of stroke play on Thursday, June 5th. The low 16 players will advance to match play, beginning on Wednesday, June 11th. There will be two matches each day on June 11 & 12. In the case of a tie for the last qualifying spot on the 5th, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff, beginning immediately following the last stipulated round. The playoff will begin on the 17th hole, then to the 18th if necessary. This sequence will be repeated. All other ties will be decided by random draw.

TEES: Play will be from the Blue CSGA tee markers.

HOLE LOCATIONS: Hole locations will be available each day at the reception table.

INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE: All on course stone walls. No free relief.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Hole # 1 The fence on the left side

Holes # 15 & 18 On or over Black Rock Turnpike, the Club entrance road or the parking lot.

Holes # 15 & 17 Over the green

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: All the bird houses, which indicate 150 yards to the greens, are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2 - No line of play relief.

WATER HAZARDS:

Hole # 5 off tee

Hole # 7 1st pond – As an additional option, use ball drop in front of pond

Hole # 8 If ball does not carry pond, ball drop near forward tee.

Hole # 12 In front of green

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:

Hole # 7 2nd pond on right

Hole # 8 Ball that clears hazard & rolls back into water on greenside. Also for Ball over green. Ball drop

Hole # 10, 12, 15 & 16 Where so marked by Red Stakes.

HOLE # 16: Left side is marked “ground under repair”.

CONDITIONS: Contestants are reminded that the following conditions are in effect:
Footwear, Cellular Phones & Dress Code

FOOD & BEVERAGES: A complimentary lunch is available in the dining room. The snack bar will not be open.
