

## **Larry Bolduc Earns Medalist Honors**

May 17, 2010 - The quest for the 2010 Richard Siderowf Senior Player of the Year began today at Gillette Ridge Golf Course in Bloomfield, CT. Seventy-three players, including two past champions, teed it up at the 4<sup>th</sup> Senior Match Play Championship with hopes of becoming the winner of the first CSGA major championship of the year.

Besides two defending champions of the event, the field also included seven Connecticut Senior Amateur champions. Larry Bolduc from Tallwood Country Club earned medalist honors with an impressive one-over par round of 73 on the challenging 6460 yard golf course. Defending Senior Player of the Year Dave Szewczul shot a round of 74 to earn himself the second overall seed.

Robert Bukowski from Goodwin Golf Course hit the shot of the day. Bukowski's six iron on the 170 yard par three eleventh hole went in the hole for the first hole-in-one of the CSGA competitive season. Bukowski ended with a total of 78 to gain the thirteenth overall seed.

A five-man playoff was needed to decide the final two qualifying spots. On the second playoff hole, John Catarino from Wethersfield Country Club and Greg Karakashian from Stanley Golf Course captured the final two spots in the match play bracket. The round of 16 will begin tomorrow morning with the quarterfinals to follow in the afternoon.
