**THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS.**

**FORMAT:** The competition consists of an 18 hole team four ball score in the AM & foursome (selected drive) for the PM. The team with the lowest 36-hole score will be the Champions. There is a prize for the over-all Champion, Runner-up & for the lowest round in the AM & PM. Teams may not win more than one trophy. In addition, the winning team will have their names engraved on the new Black Hall trophy honoring Bill Hermanson. Also, the low five teams will win Black Hall Golf Shop merchandise credit. We will use the low score in the PM round as the first tiebreaker for Golf Shop merchandise. After that we'll use The USGA recommended procedure of match of cards for merchandise gifts (best back nine holes, six, etc.). If there is a tie for the Championship, a hole-by-hole play off will start on the 1<sup>st</sup> hole, followed by the 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>. The format will be foursome play. No select drive.

**TEES:** Play will be from the CSGA Blue Tee Markers.

**HOLE LOCATIONS:** Obtain hole location sheet at the reception table. All paces are from the extreme front of the greens & 90 degrees to the side of the green.

**FLOWER BEDS:** They are obstructions & you MUST take free relief.

**STONE WALLS:** All, on course, stonewalls are considered an integral part of the golf course. No free relief.

**LATERAL HAZARDS:**

Holes 11 & 12 Left side  
Hole # 3 Pond on left side & beyond  
Holes # 16 & 17 Left of green  
Hole # 14 Starts, on right, over fairway  
bunkers & continues the entire  
right side, up to green

**OUT OF BOUNDS:**

Holes # 2 & 11 Over green  
Holes # 7 Left side  
Hole # 12 Barn on the right  
Hole # 13 Over stonewall on  
right & behind green  
Hole # 14 Right side near 13<sup>th</sup> green

**SCORES CARDS:** In the AM round, only the score for the player whose score is to count for that hole should be written on the card. Besides the marker, only one signature per team is required. **PLEASE RETURN THE SCORE CARD TO THE SCORE BOARD.**

**CONDITIONS:** Per the Letter to Contestants, the players are reminded that the following conditions are in effect: Dress Code, Footwear, Cellular Phones
