THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS.

FORMAT: 36 holes at stroke play. All contestants will play 18 holes on Tuesday & Wednesday. Pairings for Wednesday will be determined by Tuesday's score. Lower scores will tee off last on Wednesday. The player with the lowest 36 hole score is The Champion. In case of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately following the last stipulated round on Wednesday. The play-off will begin at the 1st hole, then to the 17th & 18th, if needed. All other places will be shared. There is also a prize for low amateur.

TEES: Play will be from the Blue CSGA tee markers.

HOLE LOCATIONS: Hole location charts are available at the reception table. All paces are from the extreme front of the green & to the closest side of the green.

YARDAGE MARKINGS: All sprinkler heads are marked to center of green,

STONE WALLS: All stonewalls & rocks, on the course, are considered an integral part of the golf course.

OUT OF BOUNDS: On the entire right hand side of the golf course, there is a fence or white stakes that form the OB boundary.

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS & WATER HAZARDS:

Holes # 6, 10, 13, 16 & 17

HOLE # 17 WATER HAZARD:

As an additional option, there is a drop area between the two forward tees.

IMPORTANT YARDAGES:

Hole # 6 180 yards to hazard	Hole # 10	225 yards to hazard
200 yards to carry hazard	Hole # 16	165 yards to hazard
Hole # 8 180 yards to middle of fairway		224 yards to carry hazard

FLOWERBEDS:

All flowerbeds are GUR. FREE relief MUST be taken.

CONDITIONS: Per the Letter to Contestants, the players are reminded that the following are in effect:
Cellular phones, Footwear, Dress code.

Any questions, please ask at the reception table or the starters table.

PACE OF PLAY: Please read the "CSGA Pace of Play Guidelines". If you are out of position & behind time, your group is subject to be timed. All necessary information was attached to letter to contestants. It is your responsibility to keep up with the group in front of you.

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: If a Rules Official is not immediately available, a player may play a second ball under Rule 3-3 & then you must report it to the committee before signing your score card.
