General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply. **Please note that caddies are not permitted during this championship.**

Schedule of Events:

Monday, July 8th – 18 holes of stroke play. The low 32 scores advance to match play. There will be a playoff to determine last spot(s) if necessary.

Tuesday, July 9th – Round of 32 Matches (AM) and Round of 16 Matches (PM)

Wednesday, July 10th – Quarterfinal Matches (AM) and Semifinal Matches (PM)

Thursday, July 11th – Final Match (AM)

Practice Round:

Practice Rounds are available strictly for **players only** and all players are required to walk during the practice round. **Spectator carts will not be permitted during the practice rounds or the championship proper.** The fee for the practice round is \$25 and practice rounds are available on the following days:

Saturday, July 6th – 12:30pm-2:00pm

Sunday, July 7th – 12:30pm-2:00pm

To schedule your practice round, you must call the Watertown GC Golf Shop at (860) 274-4387. **Please do not call the Watertown Golf Club and ask for alternative days for practice rounds, as they will be unable to honor your request. Limited to one practice round per player.**

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located on the patio next to the putting green upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available one hour before the first starting time each morning. Range fees for the tournament are courtesy of the CSGA.

Locker Room:

The locker room, located on the main level of the clubhouse, will be available for your use at 6:30am each day.

Caddies & Transportation:

All players are required to walk at all times during this championship. Players may either carry their bag or use their own non-motorized push/pull cart. Motorized golf carts or caddies are not permitted, and there will be no spectator carts allowed during this championship. Players are not permitted to use a caddie during any tournament round.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.

It is the responsibility of the player to be ready to play at the scoreboard area when the playoff is set to begin. Players who are not present when the playoff is set to begin will forfeit their spot. All ties for match play seeding are broken by return of card sequence.

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Junior Amateur Championship Trophy. All players advancing to the Quarterfinals will also receive merchandise certificates redeemable at the Watertown GC Golf Shop.
