



# 32<sup>nd</sup> Connecticut Mid-Amateur Championship

Shuttle Meadow Country Club

Kensington, Connecticut

August 26-27, 2019



## **General Information:**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

## **Schedule of Events:**

Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup> – 18 holes of stroke play. Cut to the low 36 scores (including ties).

Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup> – 36 holes of stroke play.

## **Practice Round:**

Practice rounds are available at Shuttle Meadow Country Club on August 20<sup>th</sup> and August 22<sup>nd</sup> after 3:00pm. The cost of a practice round is \$50 (cash only) and includes the use of a cart. To make arrangements please contact the Shuttle Meadow Country Club golf shop at (860) 229-6100.

**Course Setup:** Shuttle Meadow will play to a par 71 at approximately 6,500 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 24 minutes.

## **Registration:**

Players must check in at the player registration table located near the bag drop upon their arrival.

## **Practice Range:**

The practice range is limited to irons only and will be open at 6:30am each day. The practice range will close on Monday after the final starting time and not be open for the rest of the day. The range is located in the interior of the golf course and will require players to take a three minute shuttle ride to and from the range. Please take this shuttle time into consideration when planning your arrival time.

## **Locker Room:**

The locker room will be available for your use beginning at 6:30am.

## **Caddies & Transportation:**

The use of golf cart is optional and not included as part of your entry fee. The cost for use of a cart on Monday is \$25. The cost on Tuesday for one round is \$25 and for both rounds is \$40. All cart payments must be paid in cash only. Only two carts will be allowed per starting time. Caddies are permitted but none are available through the host club. The use of a push cart is permitted.

## **Attire:**

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

## **Footwear:**

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7 in Section 8 of the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.

## **Driver Heads & Golf Balls:**

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org) or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

**Food & Beverage:**

Lunch will be available on Monday from 11:00am until 3:00pm and from 11:00am until 2:30pm on Tuesday. Please take these lunch times into consideration when planning your arrival time.

**Play-Off & Ties:**

In the event of a tie for the championship, there will be a hole by hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of round three.

**Trophies & Prizes:**

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Mid-Amateur Championship trophy. The winner and runner-up will also receive a replica trophy. Low finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Shuttle Meadow Country Club. Ties for any position other than Champion will be decided by round three score then by a match of card.

**Player of the Year Points:**

Players finishing in the top fifteen and anyone finishing 54-holes will receive the following points toward the 2019 Dick Tettelbach Player of the Year.
