



34th Connecticut Public Links Championship

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Tuesday, August 6, 2019 – 18-holes of stroke play; field will then be reduced to the low 30 scores, plus ties.
Wednesday, August 7, 2019 – 18-holes of stroke play; low 36-hole finisher will be declared Champion.

Play-Off & Ties:

In the event of a tie for champion, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following round two.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available at Wintonbury Hills Golf Club published rates. Arrangements can be made by contacting the golf shop at (860) 242-1401 or by visiting their website at wintonburyhillsgolf.com.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the clubhouse upon their arrival.

Caddies & Transportation:

You may carry your own bag, employ a caddie, and/or use a golf cart. The use of a pull/push cart is permitted. There are no caddies available through the host club. The cost of a golf cart is not included in your entry fee. If you wish to use a golf cart you must check in with the golf shop staff to arrange the payment of \$25 per round. There will only be two carts allowed per threesome and one cart in the case of a twosome.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for your use beginning at 6:00am. Range fees are courtesy of the CSGA. The practice range is located down the road from the entrance of the club and must be accessed via car only. Please take this into consideration when planning your arrival time.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7 in Section 8 of the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

Course Setup:

Wintonbury Hills Golf Club will play to a par 70 at approximately 6,700 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 26 minutes. Please note that this yardage is subject to change and may vary from round to round

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Public Links Championship trophy. The winner and runner-up will receive a keepsake Public Links Championship trophy. Also, the low six finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Wintonbury Hills Golf Club golf shop. Ties for any other position other than Champion will be decided by round two score first, then by match of card.

Players finishing in the top ten and anyone finishing 36-holes will receive the following points toward the 2019 Dick Tettelbach Player of the Year.
