



## Qualifier – 121<sup>st</sup> United States Amateur

### **General Information:**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

### **Schedule of Events & Format:**

Monday, July 19, 2021 – Qualifying (36 Holes of stroke play)

### **Grouping & Starting Times:**

Starting times begin at 7:30am for round one and 12:30pm for round two.

### **Qualifying Positions:**

The players with the two (2) lowest 36-hole total will advance to the 121<sup>st</sup> United States Amateur Championship. There will also be two (2) alternate positions available. Should you qualify, you must accept your position and pick up the proper credentials prior to leaving the qualifying site.

### **Play-Off:**

In the event of any tie for the last qualifying place or any of the alternate positions, the players concerned shall compete in a sudden death play-off to begin immediately following the conclusion of round two.

### **Registration:**

When you arrive at the club, please check in at the reception table located in front of the golf shop.

### **Locker Room:**

The locker room will be open for your use beginning at 6:30am.

### **Practice Round:**

Practice rounds are available at a cost of \$50 (cash only), which includes the use of a golf cart, on the following dates and times: Monday, July 5 after 12pm, Tuesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> anytime, Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup> after 12pm, Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> after 3pm and Sunday, July 18<sup>th</sup> after 5pm. Wampanoag Country Club does not utilize starting times but players must confirm availability by contacting a member of the professional staff at (860) 523-8147.

### **Practice Range:**

The practice range will be open beginning at 6:30am. Range balls are compliments of the CSGA.

### **Course Setup:**

Wampanoag Country Club will play as a par 72 at approximately 6,600 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 26 minutes.

### **Caddies:**

The use of a caddie is permitted. Wampanoag Country Club does not have any club caddies available.

### **Automotive Transportation:**

The use of a golf cart during any round is prohibited.

***Pull Carts:***

The use of a push/pull cart is permitted.

***Driver Heads:***

Model Local Rule G-1 is in effect. Any driver the player uses to make a stroke must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, which is on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the USGA.

***Groove & Punch Mark Specifications:***

Model Local Rule G-2 is in effect. In making a stroke, the player must use clubs that conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules that took effect on January 1, 2010.

***Golf Balls:***

Model Local Rule G-3 is in effect. Any ball used in making a stroke must be on the current List of Conforming Golf Ball issued by the USGA.

***One Ball Rule:-***

Model Local Rule G-4 is in effect. During an entire round, each ball at which the player makes a stroke must be the same brand and model as found in a single entry on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls.

***Pace of Play:***

The pace of play policy as adopted by the Connecticut State Golf Association will be in effect.

***Attire:***

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

***Footwear:***

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.

***Withdrawals:***

You must contact the USGA Championship Department at (908) 234-2300 or the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this qualifier. A competitor who fails to notify either the USGA or CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions by the USGA.
