### ***General Information:***

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

### ***Format & Qualifying Positions:***

18 holes of stroke play qualifying. The number of players advancing will be posted when it becomes available. There will also be two (2) alternate positions available.

Should you qualify, you must accept your position and pick up the proper credentials prior to leaving the qualifying site. Any ties for the last qualifying position or alternate positions will be determined by a sudden-death playoff beginning immediately after the conclusion of play.

### ***Schedule of Events:***

Tuesday, June 11, 2019 – Sectional Qualifying (18 Holes)

### ***Grouping & Starting Times:***

Starting times will begin at 8:00am from the 1st tee.

### ***Practice Round:***

Clinton Country Club will be providing practice rounds on June 8. They will also be allowing contestants to walk the golf course on June 9 and June 10 after 5:30pm. The cost of a practice round is \$25 for contestants. If contestants wish to bring along a parent or guardian to play during the practice round the cost will be \$100 for the parent/guardian. ### ***Registration:***

When you arrive at the Club, please check in at the reception table, located in front of Golf Shop.

### ***Practice Range:***

The practice range will be available for your use beginning at 7:00am and is courtesy of the CSGA.

### ***Course Setup:***

Clinton Country Club will play as a par 72 at approximately 6,500 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 24 minutes.

### ***Attire:***

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

### ***Footwear:***

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7 in Section 8 of the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.

***Caddies & Transportation:***

A player may carry his own bag or employ a caddie. There are no club caddies available at Clinton Country Club. Players and caddies must walk at all times during the stipulated round. The use of push/pull cart is permitted. A player is not required to employ a caddie for any stage of the Championship

***Note Regarding Caddies:***

A player may not use a parent, step parent, or guardian as a caddie during Sectional Qualifying or the Championship proper.

**PENALTY:** See Model Local Rule H-1.2 in Section 8 of the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.

***Driver Heads & Golf Balls:***

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org) or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

***Limitation on Golf Balls:***

The one ball Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. See Model Local Rule G-4.

***Groove Specifications Condition:***

In Sectional qualifying and in the Championship proper, the Local Rule as prescribed by Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule G-2.

***Withdrawals:***

You must contact the USGA Championship Department at (908) 234-2300 or the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this qualifier. A competitor who fails to notify either the USGA or CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions by the USGA.
