



NOTICE TO PLAYERS
CSGA One Day Tournament
Lyman Orchards Golf Club
Thursday, September 10, 2020



This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions, which may be found on the Lyman Orchards Golf Club One Day tournament portal.

COVID-19 Rules: The following COVID-19 Local Rules are in effect: Practice, Social Distancing, Suspensions, Scorecard Returned, Competition Finalization, & Code of Conduct. Detailed information on these Local Rules can be found on the Local Rules & Terms of Competition for 2020 CSGA Championships.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day event. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 and a half hours. Please play "ready golf" as outlined in the 2019 Rules of Golf. Players may be apprised of their pace of play periodically by on-course officials.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play with both gross and net divisions.

FLIGHTS: All players age fifty-five (55) and older have been placed in the Siderowf (Senior) division and the remaining players are in the Tettelbach (Open) division. The September 10th Handicap Revision will be used for all handicap purposes.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Blue Tees**
Siderowf (Senior) Division – **White Tees or Gold Forward Tee** – Net Only Competition

SCORING: All scoring will be done through the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring App. Each group will receive a unique GGID which will be used to enter scores throughout the round. Please proceed to the scoring area immediately after the completion of play. Scores will be verbally certified by a member of the CSGA staff.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified or defined by boundary fences, white stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the boundary and lines define the boundary. On Hole #18, the driving range is out of bounds.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified by yellow or red stakes and/or lines on the following holes: #1, 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 18. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the penalty area and lines define the area. Relief is available as described in Rule 17-1.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines on the ground are considered to be Ground Under Repair. Free relief is available as prescribed in Rule 16-1.

POWER LINES: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during play of any hole, the stroke is does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made. This applies to the power lines only. The poles supporting the lines are treated as immovable obstructions.

NO PLAY ZONES: Flower beds are deemed to be no play zones and free relief is **mandatory** as prescribed in Rule 16.

PRIZES: Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Lyman Orchard G.C. Golf Shop. Additionally, the top five finishers and ties in each division will qualify for the season ending One Day Championship at Shennecossett Golf Course on October 20th.

ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen finishers in the Tettelbach and Siderowf divisions, and top three in the Super Senior category, will earn One Day Tournament Player of the Year points. One Day Players may receive points in both the gross and net division. The top three finishers in each division at the end of the year will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Chris Cote's Golf Shop in Portland, Conn.
