



NOTICE TO PLAYERS
CSGA One Day Tournament
Wethersfield Country Club
Tuesday, June 2, 2020



This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions, which may be found on the Wethersfield One Day tournament portal.

COVID-19 Rules: The following COVID-19 Local Rules are in effect: Holed, Bunkers, Flagstick, Practice, Social Distancing, Suspensions, Scorecard Returned, Competition Finalization, & Code of Conduct. Detailed information on these Local Rules can be found on the Local Rules & Terms of Competition for 2020 CSGA Championships.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day event. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 hours or less.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play with both gross and net divisions.

FLIGHTS: All players age fifty-five (55) and older have been placed in the Siderowf (Senior) division and the remaining players are in the Tettelbach (Open) division. The June 2nd Handicap Revision will be used for all handicap purposes.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Blue Tees** Siderowf (Senior) Division – **White Tees**

SCORING: Please proceed to the scoring tent at the 18th green immediately after the completion of play.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified by white lines, stakes or boundary fences. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the boundary and lines define the boundary. Any ball which crosses Highland Street, either behind the 6th or 15th greens, and lands on another part of the course is considered out of bounds. In addition, the maintenance area on Hole #16 is out of bounds.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified by red or yellow lines and/or stakes on the following holes: #6, #10, #13, #16 & #17. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the hazard and lines define the hazard.

HOLE #17: As an additional option for a ball in, or known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area, there is a drop zone located behind the red tees on Hole #17. The player may proceed under Rule 17.1 or as an additional option, drop the ball or another ball in the drop zone.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Defined by white lines on the ground. Relief is available as described in Rule 16.

NO PLAY ZONES: Flower beds located in the General Area are deemed to be NO PLAY ZONES and free **relief is mandatory**. The Weather Station located in the General Area marked by Blue Stakes on the right side of the fairway on Hole #16 is a No Play Zone where play is prohibited. Free and complete relief **must** be taken from interference from the No Play Zone as described in Rule 16.

POWER LINES: Model Local Rule E-11 is in effect. If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during play of a hole, the stroke does not count. The player **must** play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made. Note, this rule applies to the power line only, and **not** the supporting wires or pole.

PRIZES: Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Wethersfield Country Club. Additionally, the top five finishers in each division will qualify for the season ending One Day Championship at Shennecossett Golf Club.



ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen finishers in the Tettelbach and Siderowf divisions, and top three in the Super Senior category, will earn One Day Tournament Player of the Year points. One Day Players may receive points in both the gross and net division. The top three finishers in each division at the end of the year will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Chris Cote's Golf Shop in Portland, Conn.
